

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES *Proposal to extend activities to all days*

March 2024





- On short days, AUCA provides up to 2 extra curricular activities weekly to 393 students from Nursery (74) and Primary (319), of which 130 attending also El Faro, available only for EUIPO staff (Nursery 33 and Primary 97).
- A total of 31 activities are available (7 for Nursery and 24 for Primary).
- In 2024, a new call of tender will be launched by the school and the new contract will be signed only by the school and the provider.

Queries raised by parents



- AMPA has received queries to extend extra-curricular activities in nursery and primary every day as from 16:15h.
- At the moment many families pick up their children from school to take them to other places to other external activities such as sports, languages, art, etc.
- This, sometimes, implies time organisation problems as many parents are not able to pick children at 16.00.
- There is the possibility for some parents to enroll their children in El Faro, but this is not the case for children under categories II and III.
- Unfortunately, for those students attending El Faro after 16.00, the activities provided by El Faro consist of free games and watching TV and many families prefer students to go to specific activities to avoid such results.

Extension of the service: survey




- AMPA carried out a survey to parents to check their interest on the extension of the extra curricular activities.
- Scope: survey from 17/01/2024 until 31/01/2024, for parents with children in Nursery and Primary.
- The survey also contained questions on families' satisfaction level with actual provider of the extra curricular activities, AUCA.
- **185 families replied to the survey** (50% coverage of overall parents involved in these activities).

Family interested in extension of extra curricular activities




- Total answers: 184

(per section Nursery, Primary or more than one children in both sections)




Extension of the service: survey results

Satisfaction with Auca services



- Total answers: 172 Very Unsatisfied: 2
- Unsatisfied: 9 Neither/Nor: 27
- Satisfied: 64 Very satisfied: 70

Proposed improvements



- AMPA would like to propose the extension of the extra activities, from 16.15 until 18.30 for all days.
- The extra curricular activities should continue to be available to students from all categories.
- Snack should be provided by parents.
- Include this additional service in the new call for tender.

Extension of the service: Impacts on existing services



• For extra-curricular activities:

- Increased tender scope and services.
- For after-school activities (El Faro):
 - Possible impact in number of children enrolled.
 - Adjust rooms/facilities if needed.

• For other services from the school

- Cleaning services: to adjust activities based on cleaning planning.
- Facilities for sport (Mundosport): to adjust room/facilities available based on current planning from Secondary

Extension of the service: Benefits



• For the children

- Less logistic movements to run other activities.
- Able to enjoy other type of activities with their peers also from other sections.
- Improved engagement with school.

• For the parents

- Solution for those families with logistic problems (independently of their category).
- Improved engagement with school.

For the school

- Extension of the services offered to all families (independently of their category).
- Improved satisfaction from families.





- Confirmation of the extension of the extra curricular activities to all days by school management.
- AMPA to be involved in the preparation of the call for tender.
- AMPA to be involved in the selection committee.
- AMPA and school to send communication to parents for the 2024-2025 enrolment planning.
